Open: Open to all, regardless of age or gender. **Ladies:** Exclusively for women, open to all ages.

Masters: For those 40 years and older, separate recruitment for men and women.

Grand Masters: For those 50 years and older, separate recruitment for men and women. **Senior Grand Masters:** For those 60 years and older, separate recruitment for men and women.

Amateur Category (Two-day tournament)

Advanced Open: Open to all, regardless of age or gender.

Advanced Ladies: Exclusively for women, open to all ages.

Masters: For those 40 years and older, separate recruitment for men and women.

Grand Masters: For those 50 years and older, separate recruitment for men and women. **Senior Grand Masters:** For those 60 years and older, separate recruitment for men and women.

Legends: For those 70 years and older, separate recruitment for men and women.

Common Points:

For each class, a minimum of 3 participants is required to proceed. If there are 2 or fewer participants, they will be combined into a higher class. Please be

Awards

Pro Division: Awards for 1st to 4th place.

The range of awards may change depending on the number of participants as follows: For 6-7 participants, up to 3rd place.

For 4-5 participants, up to 2nd place.

For 3 participants, only 1st place will be awarded.

Amateur Division: Awards for 1st to 3rd place.

The range of awards may change depending on the number of participants as follows: For 4-5 participants, up to 2nd place.

For 3 participants, only 1st place will be awarded.
